

## **OSHA-10 CERTIFICATION**

According to Title 37, Public Property and Works; Chapter 37-23, Safety Awareness Programs; Section 37-23-6:

"Work for which OSHA (10) hour construction safety program is required. – No person, firm, entity or corporation shall enter into, engage in, solicit, advertise, bid for, or work on municipal and/or state construction projects with a total project cost of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) or more unless that person, firm, entity or corporation has an OSHA ten (10) hour construction safety program for their on-site employees."

A clear reproduction of each employee's OSHA-10 card must be furnished to Pezzuco Construction, Inc. prior to the execution of a contract document.
